Assaulted Women's Helpline

This is a toll-free crisis telephone service operating province-wide 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Trained counsellors can help victims determine their options, provide information about local supports such as shelters and sexual assault centres and help them develop an immediate safety plan. Interpreters in 150 languages, including French and Spanish, are available to respond to callers.
