

You're invited: Applying for Trillium funding to improve indoor air quality and reduce transmission of airborne illnesses

<u>What</u>: Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) Capital Grant stream is now open, with **applications due March 6, 2024.** This grant can be used to make improvements to indoor air quality and help reduce transmission of airborne illnesses in your space. We are offering personalized, online sessions with granting expert <u>Anne Morais</u> and indoor air quality experts from University of Waterloo and University of Toronto.

When: Sign up for a 25-minute virtual appointment on Tuesday February 13.

<u>Who this is for</u>: Community spaces in Ontario that are considering applying for the OTF Capital Grant stream to fund indoor air quality improvements.

You can ask about:

- Whether your organization and project are eligible under OTF's grant criteria, and which preselected project outcome best matches your project.
- The types of indoor air quality improvements that will make a real difference in your space and that would fit well with this grant.
